Venture Pistol Introduction Event - Participation and Hold-Harmless Agreement

Camp AIRY of the National Capital Area Council is conducting a *Venture Pistol Introduction Event*. Crew members will be instructed how to handle and shoot a pistol safely and be provided instruction to increase their marksmanship skills. Crew members will have classroom instruction and range instruction in which they will fire a pistol under the supervision of a trained Range Safety Officer and NRA certified pistol instructor.

Participants Must:

1. Complete the BSA 30 minute safety brief taught at Camp AIRY on Tuesday 08/15/17 during 5th period.
2. Wear all safety gear at all times while on the range.
3. Follow all safety rules provided in the training class.
4. Follow instructions of the Range Safety Officer(s) and Pistol Instructor(s).
5. Not handle any pistols until instructed to do so by the Pistol Instructor(s).
6. Be a member in good standing of Venture Crew 758 or Crew _____ and be in full compliance with all local, state, and federal guidelines, including age restrictions and original equipment manufacturer standards.
